• For parents with multiple children, we will arrange one pick up at the eldest child's time.

- For parents who have indicated they would like to participate in a sixth hour of school, we will coordinate your end time separately this week.
- Please plan on four days a week of instruction. We will reach out to you this week if this does not look possible.
- There will be no Phase One Learning the week of April 5-April 9 while teachers prepare their classrooms for students' return.
- There are no more Distribution Days scheduled for the year.
- After spring break, I will be sending out more information about what you can expect on April 12.
 Families will need to review safety protocols before children return to site.
